



Tennis Courses Terms & Conditions

1. Payment is due on a termly basis. The relevant group booking must be made and received on the 'Luke Pettit Tennis' app before you begin the course, so that we can ensure suitable coach cover and inform you if the course is still available.
2. There are no refunds for missed sessions however caused, except for outdoor rained off sessions where we will endeavour to catch up using the spare weeks at the end of term first.
3. If a player develops an injury during the term which inhibits attendance on the course, Luke Pettit must be informed before the first session missed. The subsequent sessions missed due to injury will be credited towards a future course.
4. Players must turn up in suitable attire as per the Knowle & Dorridge clothing and footwear rules. Failure to comply will result in the player not being permitted to play.
5. Parents / guardians must return to collect their child from outside the tennis court 5 minutes before the end of the session. Coaches are not responsible for the child once the session has finished.
6. Luke Pettit reserves the right to offer a more suitable course if the player is not up to the standard of the course they have applied for.
7. Luke Pettit reserves the right to cancel a course if there are insufficient numbers attending giving 48 hours' notice of this intent.
8. All players must be full playing members of Knowle & Dorridge Racquets Club to take part in coaching sessions and courses. Non members are only allowed to take part in an initial 1st lesson trial but in order to join the remainder of the course, they must become a full playing member of the club.
9. All sessions will be led by a fully accredited LTA tennis coach with a full DBS and safeguarding qualification.
10. All coaching staff will not be liable for any injury, clients and participants agree that first aid may be administered by a qualified first aider where necessary, without prior consent.
